## Exhibition Guidelines

*This exhibit is a NYSATA Youth Art Month Activity*

**All participants must register on-line: [www.nysata.org](http://www.nysata.org). Payments may be made on-line by credit card or mailed as directed below. Registrations with mailed payments will not be considered complete until payment or PO is received.**

**Eligibility:** Open to all students of NYSATA members in grades K-12

**Membership:** Participating art educators must be members of NYSATA to register. Current members log-in to have access. Join or renew on-line at [www.nysata.org](http://www.nysata.org)

**Submissions:** Please limit submission to two (2) works per school per teacher. Works must be two-dimensional and no larger than 26" x 30," including the mat or mounting and any attached typed statement.

**Registration Fee:** \$25 per teacher

**Presentation:** Mat or mount work on lightweight mat or bristol board. Do not use colored paper, foam core, canvas stretchers, or frames.

**Labels:** Labels will be generated with your on-line receipt or may be downloaded from the NYSATA website. Attach the **student portion** of the label (printed on white paper) to front lower right corner of each mat. **Don't cover the artwork with the label.**

**Deadline and Package Contents:** By **January 27, 2012**, send labeled artwork and (1) copy of your registration confirmation to: NYS Alliance for Arts Education / NYSATA Legislative Exhibit, Cultural Education Center, Floor C Room C, 222 Madison Avenue, Albany, NY 12230. **DO NOT SEND PAYMENTS WITH ARTWORK.** All payments should be sent to Terri Konu, 9200 Sixty Rd. Phoenix, NY, 13135 as directed on your on-line registration receipt.

**Shipping:** Ship in a strong, clean, reusable box in which art work is secure and can easily be removed for review and return. Print School District/City name on the bottom left corner of the carton. **Return shipping will be by UPS Ground, which will be tracked and monitored.**

**Written Statement (optional):** Include one page or less typed student statement about the artwork - the content and/or process (challenges/highlights-how the idea came to be), mounted on same matting with artwork *not to exceed 26" x 30" in total.*
