


Design Guidelines

- Generate your artwork based on the 2023 YAM theme: "Dream in Art"
- Include the name of our state (New York) in the design
- Include the Youth Art Month National Logo (page 6 for examples and sizing)
- Make sure that any lettering or logo is away from the border
- Use color in your design
- Any media is accepted
- The flag needs to be proportional to 3 feet x 5 feet. This way it will reproduce well.
 - See the provided blank flag template. This template can be used, but is not necessary.
 - NO designs should be smaller than the template provided for a quality reproduction
- Have a Parent Release form signed and submitted with the entry
- NEW: Submission must be by the teacher, students cannot submit directly
 - Must include a filled out cover sheet
- Scan, mail or submit work along with the cover sheet by November 23rd
